New art program Studio in a School finished the first cycle with lower grades. 2nd-5th grade teachers met with teaching artists to start getting trained. Second cycle with upper grades will start after the break. It will run end of February thru May. The final art exhibition for grades 2-5 will be at the first buddies in June. Emphasis is on the process vs. the eventual end project.

After the February break, K & 1 will start chess in the classrooms. On March 4th, we will have the 2nd PS 116 chess tournament which is open to everyone.

Pre K application period is open until end of March. We will have 3 classes with 54 students total. Children must be age 4 by 12/31/18 to apply and you do not need to be zoned to attend Pre K at PS 116.

Citizenship program flyers and emails went out. We need minimum amount of 15 people. This is a great opportunity. NY Historical Society is willing to host at our school.

The new library will need books. Can hold 3500 new books and non-fiction books are preferred to stock the library. Survey was sent to teachers for book wish lists. Some topics are world geography, biology, American history, black history, social studies, reading and writing and puberty. Amazon wish lists of book titles will be available so families can donate books. In addition, corporations are great to target for donations. Questions were brought up about supporting local small bookstores vs. amazon when purchasing books. This will be looked into.

There was a shift in indoor recess procedures. If children do not want to watch the movie, they can chose to read a book instead.
